## 2. Reason for the revisions

The consolidated financial results for the nine months ended December 31, 2020, have exceeded the previous forecasts, which was announced on November 6, 2020, due to cost reduction effect by productivity improvement and reduction of fixed cost, etc. in addition to the fact that sales of automotive-related products and smartphone-related products had exceeded the forecasts.

The Company has decided to revise up the full-year financial forecasts mainly based on the above situation for the nine months ended December 31, 2020.
